

**FOURTEENTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. C0783
BETWEEN THE ALAMEDA CORRIDOR TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY AND
IBI GROUP LTD.**

This **FOURTEENTH AMENDMENT** to Agreement No. C0783 is made and entered into by the **Alameda Corridor Transportation Authority ("ACTA")**, and **IBI Group Ltd.**

WHEREAS, an Agreement between ACTA and IBI Group Ltd. (IBI) was entered into commencing February 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008 for a not-to-exceed amount of \$250,000 for special professional services and system enhancements related to ACTA's Revenue Assessment and Verification System (RAVS); and

WHEREAS, thirteen amendments were subsequently issued increasing the amount of consideration and extending the term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Fifth Amendment as approved at the June 9, 2011 meeting of ACTA's Governing Board added the special professional services and system enhancements related to ACTA's PierPass Validation System (PVS); and

WHEREAS, at its November 15, 2019 meeting, ACTA's Governing Board approved an extension of the term of Agreement No. C0783 by two years, from January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 3.1, the term of the Agreement, is hereby amended to extend the term by two years through December 31, 2021.
2. Except as amended in Item 1 above, all remaining terms and conditions of Agreement No. C0783, remain in full force and effect.
3. The effective date of this amendment shall be the date of its execution by ACTA's Chief Executive Officer or Chief Financial Officer.
