

**FOURTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. C0869
BETWEEN THE ALAMEDA CORRIDOR
TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY
AND
OCEAN BLUE ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, INC.**

This FOURTH AMENDMENT to Agreement No. C0869 is made and entered into by and between the ALAMEDA CORRIDOR TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, a California Joint Powers Authority ("ACTA") acting by and through its Governing Board ("Board"), and OCEAN BLUE ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, INC., a California corporation ("Consultant").

WHEREAS, ACTA and Consultant entered into Agreement No. C0869 effective October 10, 2017 through June 30, 2020, with an optional three-year extension for professional, scientific, expert and technical as-needed consulting services for handling and removal of hazardous and non-hazardous waste from property under the management and control of ACTA; and

WHEREAS, three amendments were subsequently issued, each increasing the total amount of consideration by \$50,000, for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$200,000; and

WHEREAS, at its February 12, 2020 meeting, ACTA's Board exercised the three-year extension option to extend the term of the agreement through June 30, 2023 and approved an increase in the compensation amount by \$100,000 for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$300,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 4.2 is hereby amended to exercise the option to extend the term for an additional three (3) years through June 30, 2023.
2. Section 5.1 is hereby amended to provide an increase in total compensation of \$100,000 for a new not-to-exceed amount of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000).
3. Exhibit D. is hereby amended to add Exhibit D-1, which sets forth the rates to be utilized for the additional three (3) years through June 30, 2023.
4. All references to Exhibit D in the Agreement now include Exhibit D-1.
5. Except as amended in Items 1 through 4 above, all remaining terms and conditions of Agreement No. C0869, remain in full force and effect.
6. The effective date of this amendment shall be the date of its execution by ACTA's Interim Chief Executive Officer.

All disposal, services, non-heavy equipment rentals, and materials not on the rate sheet will be billed at cost plus a twenty percent (20%) handling charge. Heavy equipment rental will be billed at cost plus twenty five percent handling charge due to high liability cost.

PAYMENT TERMS

All terms are net-thirty (30) days upon receipt of invoice, unless previous arrangements have been made. All emergency response work for non-established customers is C.O.D.
